## DANISH HOUSE SOCIETY, THE ESTATE OF RUTH & JOHANNES PEDERSEN SCHOLARSHIPS AND THE DANISH SISTERHOOD OF AMERICA, LODGE 179 ATTENTION! STUDENTS AND SCHOLARS

To qualify for any of the thirteen scholarships: ten \$1,500 scholarships from the DHS, two \$2,400 scholarships from the estate of Ruth and Johannes Pedersen (\$2400 paid to each of the two top qualifying students) and one \$2,000 from the Danish Sisterhood of America, Lodge 179, you must meet the following criteria:

- a) Be of Danish heritage and/or family member of a past or present member (name please for verification) of the Danish House Society. If you are not of Danish heritage you may still qualify if you are a member or connected through family to a member of the Danish House Society. Please note: The membership in the Danish House Society must have taken effect at least one year prior to your scholarship application.
- b) Be a resident of British Columbia working towards a degree or diploma in an accredited post-secondary institution\*. Evidence of registration in such an institution is required along with an **official transcript of latest marks** and studies. (\*Post-secondary institution does not have to be in BC, so current residence could be for that institution. Do include your BC residence address!)
- c) Be of good character and provide **3 current written references**: at least one from a high school or college administrator, and the remainder from current reference(s) including an employer, if applicable. **References are to be current, dated and signed**.

Application should be made by a <a href="https://example.com/hand-written">hand-written letter</a> (NO computer handwriting fonts) giving your reasons for requesting the scholarship and describing your personal interests, hobbies, goals, dreams, financial need, and volunteer experience. Participation as a volunteer in Danish House Society activities should be noted. All of the Scholarships are to be awarded at the September Kro Aften at the Scandinavian Community Centre.



Denmark's Queen Margrethe II, whose half-century reign makes her Europe's longest-serving monarch, will undergo "major back surgery" later this month, the royal palace said Wednesday.

The 82-year-monarch will be hospitalized afterward and undergo "a longer rehabilitation process," the royal household said in a statement.

"During a long period, Her Majesty has been affected by problems with her back, and in recent times the situation has worsened," the statement said.

Margrethe has decided to undergo "major back surgery" on Feb. 22 after consulting with doctors, the palace said, adding that several official engagements will either be postponed, canceled or handled by other members of the royal family.

The oldest son of Denmark's popular monarch, heir to the throne Crown Prince Frederik, and his wife, Crown Princess Mary, are likely to step in as well as Margrethe's youngest son, Prince Joachim and his wife Princess Marie, and the queen's sister, Princess Benedikte.

In the past several days, Margrethe had canceled events, including the opening of an exhibition in Copenhagen.

The Danish Constitution gives Margrethe, Denmark's head of state, no political power and her duties are ceremonial. She was proclaimed queen on Jan. 15, 1972, a day after her father, King Frederik IX, died following a short illness.
