A BEQUEST - A bequest to a charity is a donation made through your will or estate. It allows you to leave a specific amount of money, a percentage of your estate, or assets (such as property or stocks) to a chosen charitable organization after your death.

A PLEDGE - A pledge to a charity is a commitment to donate a specific amount of money or assets over a period. Unlike a one-time donation, a pledge allows donors to spread out their contributions, making it easier to fulfill larger commitments.
